Dane County Youth Assessment (DCYA) 2018

Since 1980, Dane County youth in grades 7-12 have been surveyed regarding their opinions, concerns, attitudes, behaviors and experiences. Survey results provide essential data to educators, service providers, parents, policy-makers and funding bodies to inform grant writing, program development and public policy.

The Youth Assessment is a collaborative effort led by the Dane County Youth Commission in partnership with the United Way of Dane County, Public Health Madison & Dane County, the City of Madison, fifteen public school districts and one private school in Dane County.

Survey Development and Administration

Project vendor K12 Associates and a committee of educators, public health professionals, project funders, and citizen and parent representatives led the survey development. The survey includes questions about behaviors across contexts of school, peers, family and community. The 2018 DCYA includes new items on emerging issues while retaining questions from past surveys to measure trends. The 2018 DCYA has many questions from the national Centers for Disease Control and Prevention Youth Risk Behavior Survey to allow for comparisons with state and national trends. The survey development group made extensive efforts to ensure that questions are clear and understandable.

From January 15 through March 15, 2018, seventeen public school districts and one private high school participated in the Dane County Youth Assessment. The survey was administered electronically at middle and high schools to students in regular and alternative school programs. Students with special needs or reading challenges were offered assistance in reading the survey. Student participation in the DCYA was voluntary and anonymous. Parents were notified four weeks in advance of survey administration, invited to review the survey at their school district office, and given the option to select their child out of the process. While the survey is available at school district offices for public review prior to its administration, distribution is restricted until after it is administered in order to preserve the integrity of student responses.

Data Analysis and Reports

School districts attempt to survey all 7th-12th graders, with most districts capturing over 90%. Due to the size of their student populations and administration complexities, the Madison Metropolitan School District (MMSD) and the Sun Prairie Area School District (SPASD) used sampling methods to survey approximately 50% of their 7th-12th graders. The data for the sample of MMSD and SPASD students that participated in the survey are weighted to ensure representation of the entire MMSD and SPASD student bodies of 7th-12th graders. Results of student responses to survey questions are presented as percentages of the *weighted number* for each item. Behavioral risk surveys using self-report methodology are widely used and have been proven to be valid and reliable. The large number of participants in the DCYA, the fact that results are in line with national trends, and consistency in findings from year to year supports the validity of the DCYA.

This report provides a complete set of data tables with all survey questions and countywide responses by sex assigned at birth. The 2018 Overview Report summarizing key findings is available on the Youth Commission web site. Subsequent analysis will be conducted by funding partners and researchers yielding additional information about Dane County youth including comparisons, trends and factors influencing youth behavior. Reports will also be posted on the Youth Commission web page at www.co.dane.wi.us/humanservices/youth/youthhome.htm as they become available. All published reports may be printed without permission. The 2018 Youth Assessment marks the seventh time the Youth Commission has coordinated an opportunity for 7th-12th grade youth in Dane County to voice their opinions, needs, concerns and interests. This effort provides the community with information and insight on youth trends. Although not the only source of information on what is impacting youth in our community, the Youth Assessment provides one very valuable resource to inform program and policy decisions. The data reflected in this report is encouraging in some areas and concerning in others. The Youth Commission and its partners hope that youth-serving agencies, community stakeholders, parents, policy makers, school districts and youth will use this and subsequent reports to appreciate where we have been, to recognize the successes and challenges of today and to create an even brighter future for Dane County.

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Using Report Tables

All tables in the following report are constructed in the same manner. Each table summarizes the responses for **one particular survey item** for all high school students (grades 9-12). Responses are weighted, meaning that although all students were not surveyed, the data are representative of the high school population in Dane County. These tables are intended to provide as much information as possible in an easy-to-understand format.

A sample table with data by sex assigned at birth is shown below. Each table includes the survey question number with the exact wording of the survey question in the title. Responses are shown for Dane County overall, as well as by sex assigned at birth (female or male). The response selected by students is found in the Response column, along with the percentage of students who selected the response option.

Because all percentages are estimates based on a sample of Dane County students, the 95% confidence interval (CI) is provided. The 95% CI is a range that the true percentage is likely to fall within, and they provide information for how precise an estimate is. The larger the range provided the less precise our estimate is. For example, in the Table below, 23.5% of Dane County high school students self-reported anxiety. The confidence interval associated with this estimate is 22.8-24.2, which is a relatively narrow range and suggests a high level of confidence in the estimate 23.5%. We would be less confident in the estimate if the CI was wider (for example, 20.0 – 30.0). Confidence intervals are also used to understand if there is a statistical difference between two groups. When the CIs do not overlap, there is a difference between the groups being compared. In the table below, the percentage of females with self-reported anxiety is more than 2 times as high as the percentage among males. Since the confidence intervals do not overlap, the difference in self-reported anxiety between males and females is statistically different, which means that the difference between two things is likely not due to chance. When the CIs do overlap, the estimates may still be statistically different. The best way to test for differences is by using a statistical test.

In some cases, an asterisk (*) appears in the table, indicating that there is not enough confidence in the estimate to show the data. Our level of confidence in the data was determined by a measure of reliability called relative standard error (RSE). When the RSE was 30% or greater we did not show the data. We opt not to show data when the RSE is high because we could make incorrect conclusions about a behavior or outcome or a group of students. The RSE is often high with small sample sizes.
