#### **History and Process**

#### **History**

At five-year intervals since 1980, Dane County youth in grades 7-12, have been surveyed regarding their opinions, concerns, attitudes, behaviors and experiences. The purpose of the survey is to provide area educators, service providers, parents, policy-makers and funding bodies with accurate and up-to-date information to be used as a basis for the planning and development of youth programs, services and public policies. Based on reports from community agencies, it is estimated that the Youth Assessment has been instrumental in capturing thousands of dollars in state and federal grants annually since 1980.

Each survey has been a collaborative effort involving the Dane County Youth Commission, area schools, non-profit youth-serving agencies, and various public and private funding sources.

#### Dane County Youth Assessment (DCYA) Process for 2005

Planning for the Dane County Youth Assessment 2005 began in the spring of 2004. The Youth Commission created a subcommittee, the Youth Assessment 2005 Oversight Committee, to oversee all phases of planning, design and implementation of the project. Besides working with area agencies and schools to develop the survey questionnaire, the subcommittee identified funding and contracted with Brian Koenig (of K12 Associates) to design the final survey, provide data analysis, and present a series of reports.

In the fall of 2004 representatives from all Dane County school districts and funders were invited to provide input on the assessment. Representatives from 14 of the county's 16 school districts and five funding organizations met over a three-month period to determine the format and content of the 2005 questionnaire. During this time, the partners (districts and funders) critically reviewed the survey. Questions were retained, modified or added to reflect emerging trends and interests.

Ultimately, 14 school districts, representing 80% of 7<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grade students in the county, agreed to participate in the assessment. In the fall of 2004, representatives from the participating schools were trained to administer the survey to their students. Brian Koenig was responsible for the distribution, and later, the collection of the survey response forms.

Completion of the survey was voluntary and anonymous by each student. All families in every district were given opportunities to review the surveys before their student participated in the process.

Once the surveys were completed and collected, data coding and analysis occurred throughout the early months of 2005, leading to individual reports for each school district and the following surveys highlights. In the fall of 2005 there will be a series of focused reports covering specific topics such as nutrition, bullying at school, tobacco and alcohol use.

The <u>Dane County Youth Assessment 2005</u>: 7<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> <u>Grade Survey Highlights</u> summarizes student responses to select survey items and examines how a variety of personal, social and environmental factors relate to both positive and problematic youth outcomes. In addition to these highlights, the <u>Dane County Youth Assessment 2005</u>: 7<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> <u>Grade Data Summary</u>, provides a full summary, by grade level, of students' responses to all items on the survey. These data also provide additional opportunities for further analysis.

The 2005 Assessment marks the sixth time the Youth Commission has facilitated and coordinated an opportunity for 7<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grade youth in Dane County to voice their opinions, needs, concerns, interests and aspirations. The 2005 Assessment provides an opportunity to track the trends and changes encountered by our middle and high school youth over a twenty-five year period. The data is encouraging in a number of areas and identifies challenges in others. We hope that youth-serving agencies and institutions, parents and youth will see where we have been in the past, will appreciate the successes and challenges of today and will be inspired to build on the past and present to create an even brighter future for Dane County youth.

#### Understanding DCYA 2005 Data Summary

This document presents student responses to all 189 items on the 2005 assessment. Responses to each item are reported by grade level.

These data were gathered in the fall of 2004 from 7<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> grade students attending 14 Dane County school districts.

The survey was administered to all students who chose to participate during the school day. Youth who did not attend school on the day of the survey did not get measured. Also, students who are educated in alternative settings, such as home schools, mental health or drug treatment facilities, juvenile detention or other non-school environments were not surveyed.


The numbers presented in this  $7^{th}$  &  $8^{th}$  Data Summary are the tabulation of all students who provided valid responses to the DCYA 2005 survey. There were 7,892 valid surveys used as the basis for this report. Slightly less than 2% of surveys collected from each school were considered invalid and not used in the tables that follow.

The number of responses per item below will vary based on the number of students who actually answered that item or provided a valid response. This "missing data" is not included in the tabulations.
